Regularly scheduled activities will be held for our homeless residents, including meals, access to local resources, training opportunities, listing of food banks and shelters throughout the city, and assistance in filling out the forms necessary to obtain resources.

Residents returning to their communities, many parents and relatives of youth participating in our programs, will receive a community orientation, listing of local resources and programs in the community and an overview of current events.

CULTURAL EVENTS


We host community barbecues, book fairs and cultural events, to bring joy and laughter into our communities.
